Committee Meeting Minutes
18 January 2006

- Meeting Opened: 7:10pm

- Apologies: Lucy Hames, Murray Jones, Eddie Clouter
- Correspondence In: Football Club bank statements from BankWest.
- City of Canning – Application for the Club's use of Riverton Reserve. The Club must complete and submit the application by 6 February 2006.
- Correspondence Out: Formal letter from the Club to current players informing them of their total games played and the upcoming Registration Day.

Agenda Items

- Coaches for 2006: Advertisement was published in the Community Newspaper, 17 January 2006.
- TC had received a completed application form from Mick Kersey.
- RG said there was interest for the 9s Team coaching position.
- Registrar for 2006: Still no volunteer.
- MG provided a summary of what was involved with the Registrar's role and volunteered to assist the Club if required. The Committee was appreciative of MG's advice and comments.
- President's Update: RG attended the East Fremantle District President's Meeting on TC's behalf.
- RG reported the following:
- There is a proposed new discipline system where a reported player will have the option to either accept a prescribed penalty or attend a tribunal hearing.
- Clubs were encouraged not to advertise for new players outside of their prescribed zone.
- 17 Rounds this year compared to 15 in 2005.
- State wide Registration Day to be held on 26 February 2006.
- Season to start, Saturday 29 April 2006.
- East Fremantle Parade Day, 24 June 2006.
- Finals start, Saturday 16 September 2006.

Lightning Carnivals to be held over two weekends, 26–27 August and 2–3 September.

Team nominations will be \$275 per team and team nominations to be received within six weeks of the 26 February Registration Day.

Treasurer's Report: TC reported that there were no cheques issued and no deposits made.

TC informed the Committee that he had received an invoice in relation to photographs taken of the 17s team last year.

General Business: TC pointed out that the annual return in relation to the Healthway Grant was due on the 8 February. TC will table a report to present at the next committee meeting.

TC will look into the fees structure for 2006. One key consideration will be to offer discounts to families who have more than one player at the club.

RD looking into the stock situation ie shorts and socks for Registration Day.

RD and TC to follow up 17s players who have not yet returned their jumpers from last year. There are eight players involved.

The City of Canning usually invoice the club for the use of Riverton Reserve during March of each year.

TC asked BP if he would be getting involved with the Orana Primary School Auskick Clinic this year. BP said he would be happy to get involved again and that the Riverton Football Club had benefited by it's involvement in the Clinic over the last couple of years.
