Presidents Meeting Update: TC reported to the Committee.

EF DFDC wanted to finalise Lightning Carnivals asap.

The Winnacott Football Club would host the 12s Lightning Carnival.

Riverton needs to decide whether it will host the 9s Lightning Carnival. The Club wants to make sure there is no clash with the

The 12s have been allocated a Little League fixture.

Some of the 12s fixtures will be played at East Fremantle Oval on a Friday night this year. The Riverton team will be involved in at least one of these fixtures.

Legislation on how sporting clubs are to deal with children is being released, eg club officials to sign a Prohibited Persons Declaration.

Treasurer's Report: MJ advised that an invoice had been received from the Community Newspaper in relation to the advertisement for new coaches.

TC reported that East Fremantle had increased team nomination fees by \$25 per team.

TC discussed the club budget for 2006. Main issues were related to fees. New fees for 2006 are:

Auskick = \$60

15s = \$120

Discount offered to families with more than one player at the club.

10% = 2 players

20% = 3 players

30% = more than 3 players

RG said an extra set of jumpers may be required for the Auskick.

Everyone agreed that a new BBQ was required as the current one is a fire hazard.
