Presidents Meeting Update: TC reported to the Committee.

Change in legislation for working with children. Parent's with children participating are exempt from needing a Police clearance.

Ask 2006 coaches, assistant coaches and team managers to sign a declaration of good standing. It's the individual Club's decision whether or not to ask these people to sign a declaration of good standing if they signed one last year.

There are approximately 20 umpires less than last year. Therefore 9s & 10s teams are responsible for fielding an umpire at home games. The Riverton Committee discussed this issue and have decided to organise a pool of umpires, preferably adults.

TC looked at the draft copy of the 2006 fixtures. TC felt everything looked fine. 12s play 3 games at EF Oval on a Friday night. 12s also get a Little League game on either the 15 July or 5 August.
