Presidents Meeting Update: RG reported to the Committee.  
Football Clubs want some comfort that there are adequate processes in place to ensure the security and privacy of the personal data stored on the Sporting Pulse System.

On the issue of umpires it was confirmed that the 9s will not have umpires provided but the 10s will have umpires provided.

Clubs were informed that team runners cannot carry water out to players and must immediately leave the ground after delivering their message.

Players, Coaches and parents are to be reminded that bad language is not permitted. There has been a number of complaints in relation to bad language this year.

East Fremantle parade day is the 24 June 2006.

Treasurer's Report: MJ issued a Profit & Loss statement for the period 1/11/2005 – 17/5/2006.

Property Officer Report: EC is concerned that there is a short supply of large sized shorts. The Committee has authorised EC to spend approx \$500 on more shorts.
