Presidents Meeting Update: TC provided update to the committee.

TC missed most of the meeting.

EF would like Riverton to host a weekend of finals at Riverton Reserve, TC has said no, saying there was not much benefit for the club. Oval would need to be marked and organising of the canteen and BBQ appears to be too much work. The Committee voted not to get involved.

Availability of umpires for the 9s lightning carnival, Russell Masters (Umpires Adviser) didn't think they would provide umpires because they haven't provided them all year for the 9s. Riverton has asked for about 5-6 umpires for the 9s carnival.

Treasurer's Report: TC reported.

Cheques for the 11s, 10s and 12s carnivals have been issued.

Cheque for the Rossmoyne Auskick carnival has been issued.

RG queried payment to Football Commission for Auskick packs – MJ said invoice was paid on 17/5.

Cheque is required to pay for 2006 insurance (see correspondence in).

Draw cheques for Mick Kersey (10s), Mark Barrett (11s) and the 9s team for year end function, \$125 each.

Property Officer Report: EC reported that the club had purchased logos (Nik Varga) for the 11s team football jumpers, EC's mother has volunteered to stitch on the logos (so EC says).

9s have miss placed their goal umpire flags.

13s don't have goal umpire flags, will require a set for next year.

Quotes to mount Mitchell Clark's Brisbane Lions football jumper, Riverside \$285 Willetton Picture Framing \$350 - \$400. Committee decided to go with Willetton Picture Framing.

General Business: Photographs were successful, TC to now check with coaches to

make sure players names are spelled correctly before photos are printed.

TC to organize photos for new junior life members raised by BP.

TC & RG to organize year end trophies.

TC 9s carnival, have organized sound and medical support. BP & RG to organize oval marking, Dave Ellis to speak on PA and be announcer for the day, people required to staff BBQ RG will organize the BBQ roster, need marques, need 2-3 BBQs, canteen help required to serve, car parking marshals required. Expecting 12 – 14 teams. Each Riverton team will provide 2 or more volunteers.

EC asked whether the club should enter the Riverton Primary School raffle for a signed 2006 WCE football jumper. The Committee agreed to purchase \$50 worth of tickets.

RG year end wind up Sunday 10 September, 10am – 12pm.

RG Match sheets for all teams required for season end.

TC advised MK no details for the 10s carnival yet.

MG spoke on behalf of EF and the need for Riverton to host a day of finals at Riverton Reserve. Reluctantly TC and a number of other committee members agreed to assist EF and make Riverton Reserve available for finals on the 26/8. MG thanked TC and the committee for their support. MG agreed to arrange to have the oval marked.

TH advised that Wednesday 23/8 was the close off for the next newsletter.

BP spoke briefly about the Roy Kirshaw award criteria and nominations.
